

Course Syllabus

7th General Science

Course Description:

Is designed to help students start their transition into the ownership and independence of middle school. We will start with discussing what exactly science is and then venturing along the science "timeline"...learning about some scientists who have significantly contributed to the field of science throughout history. We will briefly learn about many different disciplines of science: Astronomy, Chemistry, Biology, Earth Science, Marine Science, just to name a few! We will look at the beauty and wonder of God's creation! The book is big, but written in a wonderful conversational tone.

Your student will learn note taking skills using the Student Notebook that accompanies the text. We will learn about and use the scientific method by doing experiments and write our findings up in a scientific format. We will also have the opportunity to "Explore More" as we look at the basics of some of the more common scientific concepts. This course is divided up into 2 halves and there will be a "mid-term" and a final exam.
