



Things Children Should Know For First Grade Readiness

- ✓ Students should be able to read the following words fluently: hat, net, dig, dog, top, fell, bib, sun
- ✓ Students should be able to read the following story fluently and answer the comprehension questions:
- ✓ STORY: Ned is on the box. He has a pen in his hand. A big rat is in the box. Can the dog catch the rat?
- ✓ QUESTIONS: Who has a pen in his hand? Where is the big rat?
- ✓ Students should be able to count objects, count by 10's to 100, and count backwards from 10 to 0.
- ✓ Students should know the following arithmetic problems:
